**World Dairy Expo Announces NEW 2005 Dairy Cattle  
Show Schedule, Madison, Wisconsin**

World Dairy Expo's Dairy Cattle Exhibitors Committee and Board of Directors have approved a new schedule for the 2005 event to accommodate the growing number of animals exhibited at the world-class show.

"The best dairy cattle in North America parade across the colored shavings at World Dairy Expo," says Dairy Cattle Show Manager Ryan Weigel. "Each deserves her moment in the spotlight. We're hopeful this schedule will allow for that." World Dairy Expo hosts not only seven dairy breed shows, but also the Kingsmill Farm II International Futurity, the International Junior Holstein Show and five dairy cattle auctions during the five-day event. More than 2,400 head of cattle were on the grounds last year. In order to complete nine shows in five days, several breed shows must be scheduled to take place at the same time in the Coliseum. In recent years, increased class sizes, particularly in the Jersey and Brown Swiss shows, have resulted in a crowded show ring. The Exhibitor's Committee recognized a need to rearrange the show schedule to allow adequate time and room for each of the breed shows to take place.

The Kingsmill Farm II International Futurity classes, previously held on opening day of the show, will now take place prior to the junior three-year-old class during their individual breed shows. An overall and reserve overall futurity winner will be selected immediately following the selection of the Holstein winner on Saturday afternoon, October 8th.
