

2011 ALL CANADIAN CONTEST

DEADLINE – DECEMBER 31, 2011

The All Canadian Contest was established to recognize the outstanding animals shown at fairs across the country. Classes for the 2011 contest include:

1. Junior Calf – born on or after Mar 1/11
2. Intermediate Calf – Dec 1/10 – Feb 28/11
3. Senior Calf – Sept 1/10 – Nov 30/10
4. Summer Yearling – June 1/10 – Aug 31/10
5. Junior Yearling – Mar 1/10 – May 31/10
6. Inter. Yearling – Dec 1/09 – Feb 28/10
7. Senior Yearling – Sept 1/09 – Nov 30/09
8. Milking Yearling – born after Sept 1/09
9. Junior 2 Year Old – Mar 1/09 – Aug 31/09
10. Senior 2 Year Old – Sept 1/08 – Feb 28/09
11. 3 Year Old – Sept 1/07 – Aug 31/08
12. 4 Year Old – Sept 1/06 – Aug 31/07
13. 5 Year Old – Sept 1/05 – Aug 31/06
14. Mature Cow – born prior to Sept 1/05
15. Breeder's Herd – group of 3 or 4 animals bred by exhibitor and owning at least 2
16. Junior Herd – 3 animals owned but not necessarily bred by exhibitor
17. Progeny of Dam – 2 animals of either sex, who are the progeny of one dam

Eligibility

To be eligible for entry in the All Canadian Contest the animals must meet one of the following qualifications:

1. Place 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th at either The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, Eastern National, Southeastern National, Southwestern and Central National.
2. Place 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th at any other show in North America.
3. Animals must have been shown in at least one Canadian Show.
4. Foreign owners can qualify for contest if animals qualified at any Canadian Show.

Pictures

It shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor to secure and supply the photos of animals being entered in the All Canadian Contest. The photos must be 5 x 7 unretouched black and white or coloured glossy prints.

Pictures must be made during the current year and show the animals in the same stage of growth and/or lactation as when she qualified in the show ring.

For the competition in the group classes, a composite photo of each eligible group may be used or individual pictures of each animal in the

group must be submitted. The pictures must be of the animals which are shown when the group qualified for entry. If substitutions are made in a group from one show to the next, different entries must be made for each qualifying combination. Partnership bred animals, outside the family, cannot be used in the Best 3 Female classes. (If individual pictures are used in the group classes and the animal is also entered in an individual class or another group class, a separate print must be submitted for each class.)

Entries

Entries must include one picture and a completed entry form. All entries must be postmarked by December 31, 2011. There are no exceptions. Charges: All animals entered for All Canadian will be billed \$25.00 + HST.

Judging of the Contest

1. Entries will be judged by three judges as selected by the Executive, who will select the winners by placing them 1,2,3 (with 7 pts for 1st, 3pts for 2nd, 1 pt for 3rd.) The points will be tabulated to determine the winner. (Judges who have animals in a class will have to abstain from those classes.)

Presentation of awards will be made at the CBSBA Annual Meeting - Spring 2012
